

GIVING LIFTS TO JUNIORS POLICY

POLICY OWNER(S): CLUB CAPTAINS

POLICY LAST UPDATED: AUGUST 2023

This policy applies to anyone who plays senior league matches and who may be required to give a lift to a junior (children under the age of 18).

- Juniors may only be given a lift to and from away team matches with a parent/carer's knowledge and agreement. Written consent should be obtained from a parent/guardian via email or What's App. This consent applies to all lifts and is only needed to be obtained once. Consent can be withdrawn at any time by sending an email to one of the club captains. If written consent is not given, parents/carers will need to provide transport themselves.
- Parents/carers should be given the details of each person providing a lift as well as the details of the club captains. The person providing the lift and the club captains should be given the details of the parents/carers.
- Every effort will be made to ensure there are always two adults or two juniors together in the car when a junior member is being transported.
- If at all possible, and when dropping home, the junior members to be dropped home first.
